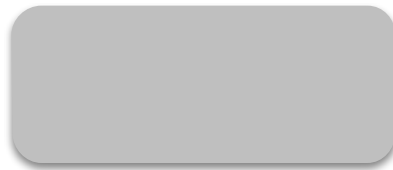
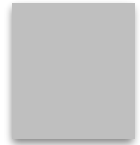
API had a busy month in April beginning with the two week Smart Point annual training. The 17 participants (plus three MTS students) took classes in pre-school education, women's activities and men's activities, The individual classes included curriculum development, English for Kids, mathematics, the eight intelligences, cooking, sewing, recycle crafts, organic gardening, computers, coconut crafts, screen printing and sprinkle batik. All the participants were introduced to special education, with the hope of developing special education as a new part of Smart Point. The next week 15 of the API team joined a team of five from Parkview Christian Church for a two-day medical clinic three hours away. The district leader was very happy with the results as over 750 people from his eight villages were served. The teamwork between the API staff the the district leaders' staff was exceptional. Close relationships were built during the outreach. There are no known Christians in the district. While culturally part of Indonesia's majority religion, the area is a center of occult activity for the whole island.

Steve and Deb are looking forward to visiting Lindsay in the fall. Both are active in disciple-making Bible studies in their Asian country. Deb continues her work with PEARL to prevent human trafficking.

Jim Yost was in California in March teaching a Disciple Making Movement seminar. He and Joani served 18 years in jungle ministry with the Sawi tribe, before beginning their urban work in Sentani, Papua. Amy works with her parents running the clinic. Jenni is working in Jakarta as a television host. Megan is married and living in the US.
