API – Thank you for all your prayers. My month in Indonesia was an opportunity to offer encouragement to the leadership team and work with the Smart Point team on the 10-day training. Two of the trainees grew up in the contextual church. They have been sent out to a community about two hours away, to plant a church where there are no Christians. Pray for this young family as they share the word of God. My last week there included a Smart Point outreach to a program on the other side of the valley. The program is held in a home on terraced rice fields. Their regular Sunday School children sang several songs in English for me. Half of the 40 young people were from Muslim homes. The Smart Point team did a fantastic job singing, playing games, doing crafts and storytelling. The large group of children ranging in age from toddlers to junior high were all totally engaged.

TROUBLED PLACES -- Thailand and Ukraine are strategic countries that include regional offices for many ministries including Good News Productions. Both countries are experiencing violence. Pray for the national and international workers serving in both countries.
